Dear practiVet,

I am writing to let you know I tried your OcluVet TM on my Miniature Pinscher, Beanie, who suffers from corneal dysplasia, and have seen quite an improvement using one drop in each eye twice a day.

For years I treated her with antibiotic and corticosteroid eye drops and ointments, with disappointing results. I tried cyclosporine also, with no improvement noted.

The OcluVet TM Nutritional/Lubricant Eye Drops have resulted in a more comfortable, better looking eye than other treatments I have tried. Her corneas still have a layer of hyperpigmentation, but they are smooth and shiny now instead of bumpy and dull-looking.
